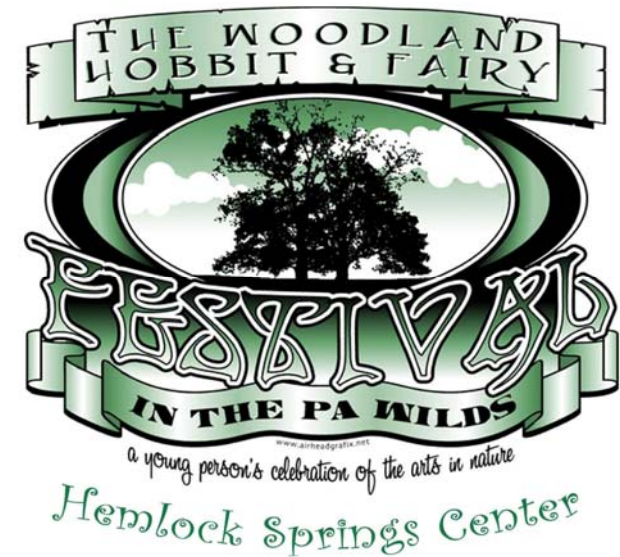

### Theme/Purpose:

The purpose of this particular competition is to place the winning artist's artwork on the cover of a thank you card. The thank you cards are to be sent to those that participate in our 2009 Messages of Caring program. The program is to request messages of caring from children and adults everywhere. The children will send their messages with their artwork to the Head Hobbit & Queen Fairy who will then distribute one message to all those that attend the 2009 Woodland Hobbit & Fairy Festival. The remaining messages will be distributed amongst numerous hospitals that care for sick children, including St. Jude's. Those children or adults that want a thank you card from the Head Hobbit will send a #10 SASE in which the winning artist's artwork will be on the cover of a Thank You Card with a note and signature from the Head Hobbit & Queen Fairy on the inside.

### Eligibility:

This competition is open to anyone that has an interest. The only limitation is that entries must represent original works of 2-dimensional art or design and be no larger than 10" X 4" in size. Your artwork **must be** nature oriented to follow with the nature based theme of the Woodland Hobbit & Fairy Festival.

### Media:

This competition is open to 2-dimensional arts. They can be drawings, paintings, computer creations, etc...

Please mail your original piece of artwork to the address on the entry form. If you would like your works returned, please include a Self Addressed Stamped Envelope.

### Prizes:

1st Prize will receive 4 entry passes and 1 parking pass to the 2009 Woodland Hobbit & Fairy Festival and their artwork will be printed on the cover of the Thank You cards. The artist will also receive a thank you on our website and a paragraph in the 2009 program.

### Judging:

This years contest will be judged by the Woodland Hobbit & Fairy Festival Council on or about May 10th, 2009.
